- Resident in Leeds, or attending school or college in Leeds

Important: PLEASE NOTE CLYM groups are subsidised by Leeds Music Education Partnership (LMEP). LMEP funding is intended for Leeds children. Places will only be offered to applicants NOT resident or attending school within Leeds Metropolitan Area if there is a space which has not been filled by a qualified applicant from within Leeds. Those from outside the Leeds area who gain a place in a CLYM group will be offered that place for one year only: they will have to re-apply in subsequent years and may lose their place if a suitable candidate applies from within Leeds. (Continuing CLYM members who are not Leeds-based, but who originally applied prior to 2015, will keep their place according to the policy that was current at the time of their application).

Auditions for City Of Leeds Youth Orchestra and City of Leeds Youth Wind Orchestra

Auditions will take place on Saturday 18th June 2016, and potentially on subsequent Friday evenings according to demand. **Audition slots will be allocated on a first come, first served basis** – we will try to accommodate requests for particular time slots but this cannot be guaranteed. We aim to provide an accompanist on Saturday 18th June but cannot guarantee to do so on subsequent dates.

Please return your application for audition by 27th May 2016. If you wish to use our accompanist, please include a copy of the piano part with your application. (This can be a photocopy, but you <u>must</u> bring the original part to your audition.) You should prepare two short contrasting pieces / sections with a total playing time of 8 minutes: please choose pieces you enjoy playing and that are well within your capabilities. If using an ArtForms accompanist, only one of the two pieces should be accompanied, to allow time for them to rehearse with each candidate. You will also be asked to attempt some sight-reading.

City of Leeds Youth Training Orchestra and City of Leeds Youth Training Wind Orchestra

If there are more applications than places, CLYTO and CLYTWO reserve the right to hold auditions. If this is required, we will let you know in good time.

If it is not possible to find a place for any applicant in the group of their choice, we will make every effort to find a place for them in another suitable group.

Ensembles run by other Leeds Music Education Partners Leeds Youth Opera
