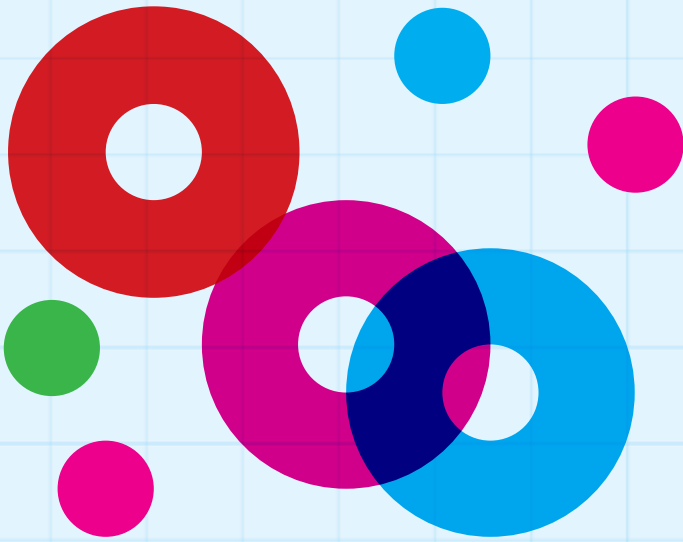

SatARTday Club: Leeds Art Gallery drop in, monthly creative activities inspired by a collection or temporary exhibition artwork. Free

Artspace: Leeds Art Gallery themed open access area to inspire creativity and imagination. Drop-in during opening hours. Special help on hand or artists in residence during holidays. Free

Rory's Saturday Club: Leeds City Museum art and craft activities, term-time Saturdays. Free

Arty Smarties: Abbey House, weekly, Sunday afternoons 2–4pm. Drop-in craft activities for families in the Victorian Street, entry charge

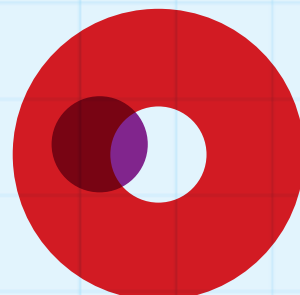
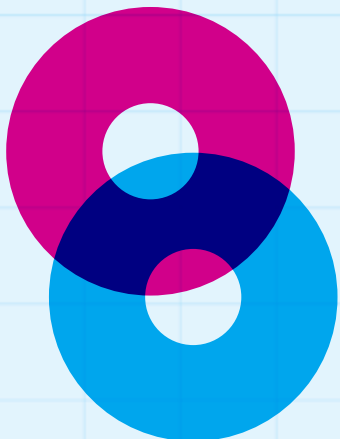
Exhibitions
