

The Carriageworks Theatre Academy

The Carriageworks Theatre Academy meets on Saturdays, to create three original performances each year.

Aged between 10- 16, Academy members work as a team of young theatre makers; performing, writing and directing to build new performances from thought-provoking starting points.

The Academy is involved in several community performance opportunities each year including Light Night, Holocaust Memorial Day and a Main Stage run at Carriageworks Theatre. The Academy runs for 11 months September to July.

South Leeds Youth Theatre





Playhouse Youth Theatre

West Yorkshire Playhouse's Youth Theatre is for young people aged 11-19, with a Technical Theatre strand for 16-19 year olds.

Weekly workshops focus on a range of techniques leading to final performances in the theatre. Young people learn from our in-house team of experts how to make theatre from scratch.

Sessions create a platform for new performance work that responds to the lives of Youth Theatre members, exploring the diversity of their experiences and developing self-confidence.

Groups meet on Wednesday or Thursday evenings or Saturday mornings, term time only. Cost: £90 per term.
