Cave Art Rocks!

With Tina Roberts

Cave Art Rocks is a practical one day workshop where pupils explore and discuss cave art reproductions and create their own prehistoric animal drawings and paintings.

Pupils will collect ideas relating to elements of art including line, shape, colour, form and media. They will be encouraged to express personal ideas and feelings about the images and will discuss the possible reasons why they were made. Natural pigments will be also be shown so pupils understand where cave art colours came from.

Then, working independently or as part of a group pupils will make cave painting images with natural materials and art media which could include:

- Classroom cave – empathise by working in dark, cramped conditions and in awkward positions
- Adding cave texture to paper
- Painting animals with paints, pastels and chalk in the cave painting colour palette
- Drawing animals with charcoal
- Making negative hand prints
- Overlaying and overdrawing images
- Finding out how to paint high up on an out of reach wall.

Possible alternative sessions and activities

1. **Colour mixing investigation...** How many ways can you make a brown (natural cave art) palette when you only have red, blue and yellow?
2. **Media investigation...** Going outside to collect materials to use as paint and make marks with e.g. feathers, leaves, soils, berries. Then coming back inside to make paints and mark making tools, and in the process learning to recognise familiar plants, their properties and how to keep safe.
3. **Fire lighting and charcoal burning ...** Making a fire outside and making charcoal to make own drawing sticks and paints.

What will the school need to provide:

This session will require a teacher present at all times, additional support where necessary and a classroom with space to work in and access to water/washing up facilities. The school will be expected to provide normal school resources and support – see below.

- Photocopying of digital resources
- Scissors, masking tape, blu-tac, drawing pencils, paint, oil and soft pastels, paint brushes, water containers, mixing pallets and plain paper
- Cave Art Paper - neutral coloured sugar paper for cave painting to resent cave walls e.g. white, cream, beiges, browns, yellows

Cost and availability:

This workshop is available to book from September 2015 to July 2016 on Mondays and Fridays only. It is suitable for one class of 30 pupils.
