A workshop exploring Music, Story and Visual Art

Suitable for KS2 pupils





Equal Arts with Musical ARC

This workshop, led by able-bodied and disabled artists, aims to give children a positive view of disability, whilst using the arts as a way in which to discuss some of the issues around disability.

This full day workshop offers a lively combination of discussion, performance and hands-on activities and skills development. The workshop covers music, art and creative writing woven around a central story. It includes:

- **A whole school assembly and performance** in which all pupils participate. There will be an introduction to the day, a short film introducing one of the Musical ARC members and a Q & A session where a Musical ARC member will openly discuss their disability.
- **Workshop activities for up to 60 KS2 children** divided into 2 groups. Children will carousel around different activities including music skills, interaction and communication with disabled members of the group, storytelling & art.
- **A final performance/sharing assembly** where pupils and Musical ARC members share the experience of the day. Part of this will be a showing of art work or reading of any creative writing and a shared song with some pupils performing music from the day.

What the school will need to provide:

- Teachers and support staff need to be present at all times.
- Musical ARC will need 2 large, wheel-chair accessible rooms to run the carousel of workshops and use of a room at lunchtime. Accessible toilets required.
- Materials needed include pencils, scissors, paper and card.

Cost:

ArtForms Arts Development SLA schools- this Creative Project is at a **discounted** rate of £400

Non SLA schools- there will be a charge of £500 for this Creative Project.

- Workshops are only bookable on Mondays throughout the academic year.

Musical Arc has been in operation for 30 years. Both lead musicians are experienced workshop leaders and have a deep knowledge of working with children in an inclusive and creative way.
