

The Artemis Collection is housed in premises in Holbeck and consists of around 10,000 artefacts and 3,000 original works of art which support classroom teaching and learning. Included in the Collection are paintings, prints, drawings, ceramics, photographs, textiles and sculpture for you to borrow for your school. Loans of art can be arranged so that you can borrow up to 20 artworks for an extended period of time.

We are delighted to offer this exciting workshop for primary schools.

Groups of up to 30 pupils can visit us and select their own artworks, which will then be delivered back to school for you to work with or to simply enhance your school environment.

'Curate Your Own Art Gallery' session aims to:

- Introduce pupils to the Collection and basic curating techniques
- Develop an awareness of different types of art – e.g sculpture, paintings, prints
- Improve and enhance pupils critical and analytical skills
- Provide schools with a unique and rich resource to inspire learning, support the curriculum and help develop a robust art practice.
- Support the development of Project Based Learning in schools

How does it work?

- Session lasts for an hour and a half
- Pupils are shown round Artemis and the Collection before splitting into smaller groups to make a selection of art
- Groups then share their choices with the rest of the class
- Selected art is delivered to school by our drivers
- School keeps the artworks until the end of the academic year

This activity can contribute towards Arts Award.

What is the cost?

One session of 'Curate Your Own Art Gallery' is available **at £120** for Leeds Local Authority schools and academy schools who have a service level agreement with us. For non-service level agreement academies and schools outside Leeds there is a charge of £390. This covers the session at Artemis and the loan of works. Delivery and collection is available and costs for this will be negotiated according to distance.

This offer is available until the end of the current Academic Year 2017/2018. All artworks need to be returned to Artemis in July 2018.
