BUILD A BAND TWILIGHT CPD

Tuesday 21st March 2017 at Leeds City Academy, Bedford Field, Woodhouse Cliff, Leeds LS6 2LG, 4 – 5.30pm

In order to support staff, we have created a package which includes a Teachers' CPD session and accompanying resources. Schools must commit to taking part in all elements of the package as follows:

- Attend the twilight CPD session on using the 'Just Play' resources lead by one of the Musical Futures team on Tuesday 21st March, 4 – 5.30pm at Leeds City Academy, Bedford Field, Woodhouse Cliff, Leeds LS6 2LG
- Indicate which instruments they would be interested in to supplement their department's resources in order to create a whole class band for KS3 classes
- Complete a data return form (if not already completed) detailing pupil involvement in music provision which takes place in your school. Involvement in the Build A Band project is conditional on activity in the academic year 2016-17 being received.
- Provide evidence of a classroom performance or concert using 'Just Play' material involving at least one entire KS3 class (this can be a short video clip)
- Give a short description of why this project will help the school to further develop music learning in your classroom and what outcomes you are hoping for from your students

Up to **10** schools will be able to access this package. We anticipate a high demand - all schools are welcome to apply for the Build A Band Project on a first come, first served basis.

The following instruments are currently available to schools selected to participate in the Build A Band project.

Whilst every effort will be made to ensure that all requests for instruments are met, we will allocate instruments evenly according to demand.

Please note: Schools are responsible for:

- Collection, safe keeping and return of any allocated instruments
- Maintenance, repair or replacement of items whilst in their care as required
