This full day, hands-on course aims to develop delegates' confidence and practical expertise in some of the more technically demanding aspects of design and technology at KS2. The course will start with a strategic overview of D&T, including key issues raised by Ofsted, and strategies for planning, progression and assessment.

The remainder of the day will be used to develop practical skills, techniques and know-how in mechanical and electrical systems and to produce teaching aids that can be used back in school.

The course will include:

- Ofsted and Primary D&T key issues and strategies for the subject leader
- Ensuring progression in children's learning
- Developing an assessment system
- Long and medium-term planning
- Workshop 1: Electrical systems
- Workshop 2: Mechanical systems, focusing on gears and pulleys

Delegates will be able to take the projects made in each of the workshops back to school with them. This includes all the relevant materials and equipment.
