



Portrait Perfect!

Alan Pergusey

Develop pupils' drawing or painting skills and support them to become portrait artists

This half day workshop will teach pupils how to draw and paint a portrait. It will use measurement and shapes as the basis for drawing a representation of a head, supporting the pupils to develop their observation skills and their technical ability in art, using readily available art materials. The workshop is aimed at a class of 30 for half a day or two classes over a whole day and supports the Art, Craft and Design National Curriculum.

During the session, pupils will:

- Learn how to look at, and identify, proportion
- Develop their observation skills
- Explore how shading can be used effectively
- Apply the use of colour and how to mix colours to create realistic flesh tones

Scale and materials can be experimented with during the workshop depending on the ability of the class and the final learning outcome. Pupils will have the opportunity to work on a large scale and on a variety of different types of paper.

What will the school need to provide?

- 2B pencils
- rulers
- rubbers
- sharpeners
- white A4 paper
- Teacher / Teaching Assistant support

The session can be delivered using other mark materials such as: charcoal, pastels, chalks, inks, watercolours, ready mixed paints, acrylic paints. A3 and A2 papers, coloured papers, small canvases or boards for painting on. Alan can work with the resources available at the school. However, if you require advice about additional materials, Alan would be happy to advise.

Cost:

£170 half day (1 class)

£300 full day (2 classes)

Alan Pergusey has over 20 years' experience of leading visual arts workshop sessions in education and the community. He has worked with pupils of all school ages, from nursery to KS4, leading sessions that last from one day to a week or more. Alan has worked with a wide range of 2D and 3D media such as painting, sculpture and mosaic and enjoys facilitating the students to create artworks that they wouldn't usually have the chance to make.
