

Exploring Hockney

Investigating colour and mark making in paint



Curriculum links: Art, Craft and Design

Suitable for Key Stage 2



This half day workshop will extend pupil's understanding of David Hockney's work and develop their practical painting skills. The pupils will work from a range of landscape photos (provided by Alan) to create their own painting in the style of David Hockney.

Alan will explore the colour wheel, highlighting the relationship of primary and secondary colours in the Hockney landscapes, focusing on the bright bold colours and pattern in the landscapes.

During the session, the pupils will:

- Develop their practical understanding of how to use paint in a variety of ways to create different effects and to layer and develop colour
- Use a variety of brushes and types of mark making to create different textures
- Find out about the application of colour through a practical process

This is a half day workshop, suitable for a class of 30 pupils.

What will the school need to provide?

- 3 sheets A4 cartridge paper x number of students
- A4 colour printouts of York landscapes x number of students
- Wide flat brush (approx. 2cm), round brush (approx. 1cm), detail brush x number of students.
- Ready mix paints, PVA
- Pots and pallets
- Paper towels or rags for cleaning brush
- 2 members of staff to assist with refilling water pots and paint

If you require help sourcing the materials, Alan is able to provide these, but there would be an additional cost of £25.

Cost

£170 half day (1 class)

£300 full day (2 classes)

Alan Pergusey has over 20 years' experience of leading visual arts workshop sessions in education and the community. He has worked with pupils of all school ages, from nursery to KS4, leading sessions that last from one day to a week or more. Alan has worked with a wide range of 2D and 3D media such as painting, sculpture and mosaic and enjoys facilitating the students to create artworks that they wouldn't usually have the chance to make.
