Sculpture In Your School!

with Alan Pergusey

Using newspaper, cardboard, sticky tape and plaster this workshop explores a straightforward approach to creating 3D art

This full day introduction to sculpture uses simple materials as a basis for creating large sculptures. They can be created around a theme to support what is being taught in class. It is suitable for up to 30 pupils (one class) who would work with Alan in small groups over the course of the day.

Newspaper sheets are screwed up into a ball and then taped together to build up larger forms. Thin rods can be added to the forms to strengthen them and plaster impregnated bandage is laid over the newspaper so that, when it dries, it will have a tough shell that's ideal for colouring with paints.

This is a project with a collaborative outcome, where pupils work together to create a large scale piece of work. It is an ideal opportunity to develop some cross curricular work.

What will the School need to Provide:

- A classroom with tables and a sink
- Covers for tables
- Members of staff in support (e.g. teachers, TA's)

Cost:

£300: this covers 1 day of Alan's time.

Alan Pergusey has over 20 years' experience of leading visual arts workshop sessions in education and the community. He has worked with pupils of all school ages, from nursery to KS4, leading sessions that last from one day to a week or more. Alan has worked with a wide range of 2D and 3D media such as painting, sculpture and mosaic and enjoys facilitating the students to create artworks that they wouldn't usually have the chance to make.
