A recent [study](#) for the Education Endowment Foundation (EEF) found pupils who participated in weekly philosophical enquiry made gains in their reading and maths scores with disadvantaged children also improving their writing.

This two-day accredited course in Philosophy for Children (P4C) will introduce the basics of P4C and give you the tools to get you started practising P4C with your students. The course will be delivered by [Thinking Space](#) - a social enterprise that creates interesting and inclusive spaces for people of all ages to think philosophically together www.thinkingspace.org.uk

By attending the course you will:

- Understand the theory and practice of P4C
- Develop the tools to support your pupils' thinking skills
- Connect philosophical enquiry to the curriculum
- Have the opportunity to put philosophical enquiry into practice
- Receive the basic philosophy resources to get started
- Gain the SAPERE initial practitioner certificate

This training is led by [Grace Robinson](#). Grace is a philosopher working wherever philosophy can make itself useful. She is the Founder and MD of Thinking Space, a [SAPERRE](#) accredited trainer and frequent collaborator with prominent educational and arts organisations. Grace has trained primary, secondary, FE, and HE teachers, artists and community workers to use philosophical enquiry in their own practice. As a Teaching Fellow at the University of Leeds she runs 'Leeds Philosophy Exchange', a project that brings together philosophy students, teachers and children in weekly P4C. As an academic philosopher, Grace writes and presents on a number of topics including philosophical enquiry. Grace is studying for a PhD in Philosophy of Education at UCL.
