Play is instinctive in children and games are often the gateway activity into an exciting world of outdoor learning.

In this session, Forest School Practitioner Annie Berrington from Get Out More, will share some games to engage and motivate children and have fun whilst discovering more about themselves, their classmates and the great outdoors.

From warm-up activities to wide games via team building, adventure and creativity, the games will offer ideas to support learning, through making the most of the outside space and easily accessible resources such as rope and sticks.

The session aims to inspire participants with a range of playful ideas to take back to school and the confidence to try them out this summer term.

Annie Berrington has a wealth of knowledge of working with children and teachers in the open air and believes we all need to get out more. This led to her establishing Get Out More CIC; a social enterprise which aims to help people of all ages get more out of life through engaging with the environment. A qualified and experienced forest school practitioner, she also works on outdoor learning, creative and nature programmes with schools, nurseries and groups across Yorkshire, using the outdoors as a tool to develop learning, motivation, social skills and emotional wellbeing. She runs outdoor literacy and design technology days for ArtForms and works with staff to develop skills and confidence in outdoor working relating learning to EYFS and the National Curriculum.
