

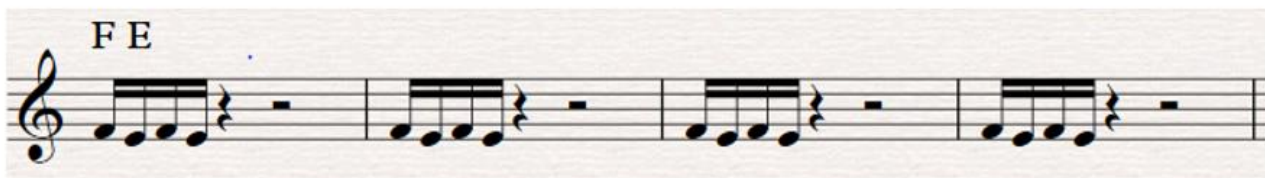
CUCKOO

1. **The Cuckoo** - The Cuckoo's call uses only two notes - A and F. Count two beats rest between the calls and play at a moderate tempo.



Robin

2. **The Robin** - The Robin's call also uses two notes - F and E. Play 4 fast semiquavers and count '2, 3, 4' beats after each set.



SONG THRUSH

3. **The Song Thrush** - The Song Thrush's call uses a repeated pattern (an **Ostinato**) which is played 3 times before one beat's rest



Rooster

4. **The Rooster** - This birdcall uses a dotted rhythm. Try saying "Cock-a-Doodle-Doo" as you perform to help you get the correct "bounce" to the rooster's birdcall.



Nightingale

5. **The Nightingale** - The Nightingale has the most complex of birdsongs. The first bar contains fast notes, while the next three bars have longer notes.
