Terms of Reference

Leeds CEP seeks to address inequality in Leeds by ensuring all children and young people have access to a high quality arts and cultural education offer that responds to their needs. It brings together arts, cultural, educational and community organisations, businesses and the local authority to create an evidence-based, joined-up approach to strategy and investment.

Acting Chair: Liz Harrop (University of Leeds)

Executive group: Sarah Westaway (Artforms), Sarah Beckett (IVE)

Role of Group:

- To influence and inform joint strategic cultural education programmes and policies within the city
- To champion and advocate for the value of cultural education and increase its reach within the city and with funders and stakeholders
- To direct the activities of sub-working groups to deliver specific actions to support the objectives and performance of the partnership.

Dissemination: Activity and recommendations from the group will be reported to the wider Leeds CEP membership. A line in to City Development and Children's Services will be maintained but this will not be a reporting relationship.

Operation: The Leeds CEP steering group will meet at least three times per year in line with academic terms.
