


# Brilliant Bayeux!

Create the Bayeux Tapestry in clay



Curriculum links: History, Art, Craft and Design

Suitable for Key Stage 2



**Everyone loves working with clay! It's messy, it's stimulating, and it brings a topic to life!**

Children will create their own clay model of an archer or foot soldier from the Bayeux Tapestry.

They will develop clay modelling techniques, learn about the appropriate use of tools and develop skills in accurately reproducing human forms and postures in three dimensions. Each child will produce a clay model, which will subsequently be fired and returned to the school.

Sam can work with two classes of up to 30 pupils – one class in the morning and one in the afternoon.

**What will the school need to provide?**

- Clay – 2 x 10kg bags per KS2 class (YPO 755117 Terracotta Clay). It's important that you buy this clay and don't substitute for another. Whilst the clay specified is not in the YPO paper catalogue, they do stock it.
- Newspaper – small pile
- Water pots and access to water
- A space to work in, which will not remain pristine.
- Pencils for marking in the clay
- Teacher / teaching assistant support – one or two, depending on group size. They will be involved in the whole session; learning the techniques Sam teaches, then helping the children with their work.

**Cost:**

**£285** This includes the cost of one firing which is carried out at another location.

**Sam Paechter** has been using clay in primary schools since 1995. During that time he's worked with children to produce thousands of pieces of work, ranging from small models, pots and tiles to large communal pieces like the many clay murals and signs which adorn the walls of schools around Leeds.
