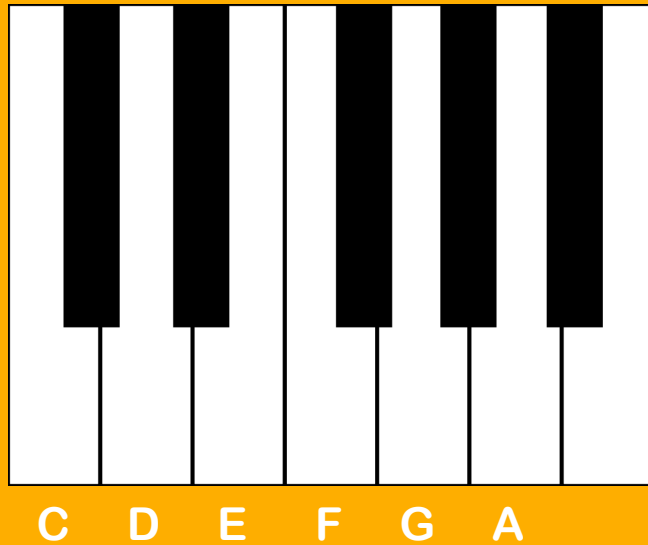


I can **move** my fingers

To play an 'A' with the right hand, we will need to move our fingers

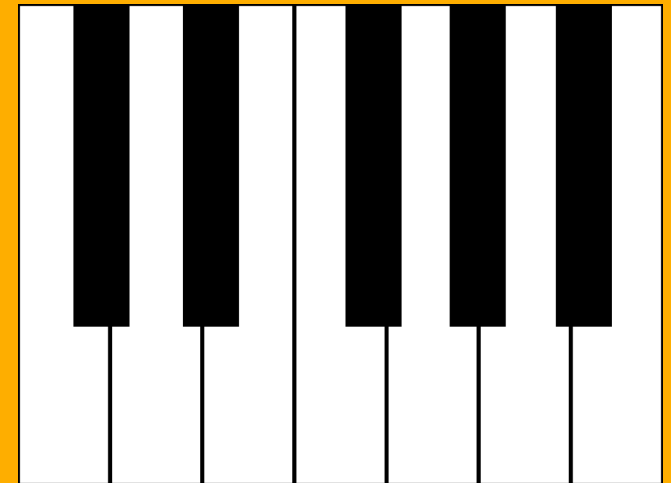

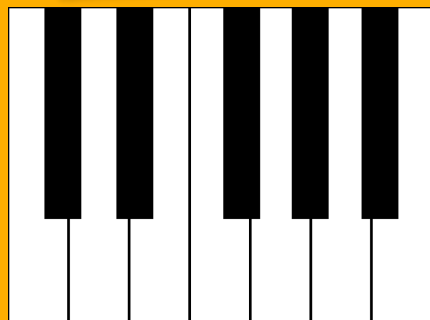


Twinkle twinkle little star
