THE GLOCKENSPIEL

The plates of a glockenspiel are metal. [This glock has sharps + flats.]

Notes go up in alphabetical order, and get higher in pitch, from left to right.

1. This diagram is of a glockenspiel [metal notes] or xylophone [wooden notes] which includes the sharps and flats [black notes]. Print or copy it as for Lesson One, and colour code the following chords
2. As before we are going to create two-note chords.
3. Colour code the chords by putting the correct coloured dots on the notes.
4. Also add the coloured chords of D and B^{flat} to your original supersize paper soprano pan.
5. Here are the chords in their colours:

Chord of C = C G	Chord of G = G D,	Chord of F = F C
Chord of D = D A	Chord of B^{flat} = B^b F	<i>*If you are colour blind skip this step</i>

6. Copy or print the **This Old Man** worksheet above, and colour in the chord names in the outline capital letters.* See partly coloured songsheet below to get you started.
7. Now, get two pencils or two sticks, and follow this chord sequence. When you see a big block capital letter you tap both the letters [notes] four times on your glock diagram while singing or saying the words to **This Old Man**.
8. You could also tap the songsheet, tapping four times on each box [aka bar]
