
Miss Smith's Enchanted Garden Suite Duet – Red part

Movement 1: Fairy Wings

When you are ready to, play along with the mp3 track *Enchanted Garden - Fairy Wings*. There is a 2-bar introduction – count *1 2 3 4 1 2 3 4*....



Watch out for the repeat! When you get to the end of the piece, go back to the start and finish where it says *Fine* ("the end").

Can you see the repeated sections? The first half has the same notes as the second half.

Can you remember what *arco* and *pizz*. means? *Arco* means play with your bow and *pizz*. (or *pizzicato*) means pluck your strings.

Movement 2: Wishing Well

When you are ready to, play along with the mp3 track *Enchanted Garden - Wishing Well*. There is a 2-bar introduction – count 1 2 3 4 1 2 3 4....

Play this smoothly (legato).

The repeat is the same as in the first movement. Play until the end and then repeat the first section.


Use small bows in the middle of your bow to help with the string changes. Practise slowly first and then gradually build up the speed. Use longer bows in the second section.



Movement 3: The Fairy Floss Tree

When you are ready to, play along with the mp3 track *Enchanted Garden – The Fairy Floss Tree*. There is a 2-bar introduction – count *1 2 3 4 1 2 3 4....*

Watch out for the rests. Listen to the backing track first to help you with this.



If you have started to learn your left hand fingers, try the Orange award version of these pieces.
