Movement 1: Fairy Wings

When you are ready to, play along with the mp3 track *Enchanted Garden - Fairy Wings*. There is a 2-bar introduction – count 1 2 3 4 1 2 3 4....



Watch out for the repeat! When you get to the end of the piece, go back to the start and finish where it says *Fine* ("the end").

Can you see the repeated sections? The first half has the same notes as the second half.

Can you remember what *arco* and *pizz*. means? *Arco* means play with your bow and *pizz*. (or *pizzicato*) means pluck your strings.


Movement 2: Wishing Well

When you are ready to, play along with the mp3 track *Enchanted Garden - Wishing Well*. There is a 2-bar introduction – count 1 2 3 4 1 2 3 4....

Play this smoothly (*legato*).

The repeat is the same as in the first movement. Play until the end and then repeat the first section.

Can you spot the use of the D major scale in this piece? It is a good idea to warm-up with your D major scale before playing this piece.



Movement 3: The Fairy Floss Tree

When you are ready to, play along with the mp3 track *Enchanted Garden – The Fairy Floss Tree*. There is a 2-bar introduction – count *1 2 3 4 1 2 3 4....*

Watch out for the rests. Listen to the backing track first to help you with this.
