DYNAMICS

- Think about the *crescendo* Get <u>gradually</u> louder!
- Mind the *subito* (sudden)
 dynamics. Play them clearly
 and make a definite contrast.

FEEL

 This is very energetic. It was written as a celebration piece. Pace yourself and keep up the energy and enthusiasm, especially at the end!



EXTRA USEFUL TIPS

- Practice your shifts separately (from 3rd to 2nd and then 2nd to 1st during bars 9, 11 and 13).
- Build up your trills gradually note by note. Start with one quick upper note, then two notes....

RHYTHM

- Don't rush the dotted
 rhythms for the dotted
 crotchets (bar 3), wait for the
 feel of the second beat. For
 the dotted quavers (bar 6),
 think "pas-ta pas-ta".
- The semiquavers aren't as quick as they look! Think
 "coca-cola, coca-cola" as you play them. Don't panic!
