

Welcome to the Steelpans and Mixed Percussion page. We realise that if you play steelpans and mixed percussion [glockenspiels, xylophones, chime bars, djembes, barrels etc] you probably do not have these instruments at home. Therefore the first lessons for you are worksheets on steelpan and glockenspiel, and how to fashion them out of paper and card, so that you recreate the feel of physically tapping the notes. Next we have some on how to create your own untuned percussion [drums, djembes etc] and some rhythms to play. Also as many of you may have a piano or piano keyboards at home, we also include some parallel worksheets on keyboards.



Coming up will be some suggestions for virtual steel pans, keyboards and assorted percussion, and some notes on the different types of all these instruments.
