DYNAMICS

- P—piano & espressivo.
 Don't start too quiet
 so you can drop to pp
 at bar 11.
- There are lots of dynamic changes—find them and make sure you're doing them!
- Diminuendos, crescendos.



Ballad II

'Molto moderato' quite fast but it is a calm, melancholy melody.

FEEL

Notice the slurs they will make it sound smooth and sad.

RHYTHM

- Notice where you have quavers, crotchets and minims.
- Make sure the minims are long enough.
- Watch out for the tied note (3 beats) at bar 19.

EXTRA USEFUL TIPS

- There is a really helpful 'play along' video of this piece on YouTube.
- See if you can make it sound quite sad.
- The lines above the notes at 37 mean sustain the notes—play with long bows.
- Look out for the repetition.
- Remember the *pizz* at the end!
