## **DYNAMICS**

- Piano (p) at the start and finish, for the same music
- Contrast forte (f) in the middle section
- Dynamic changes are usually sudden

## FEEL

- A fast piece from a series of courtly dances - a happy celebration.
- \* A Baroque piece (1738), so the style is light, with space between the notes.

## EXTRA USEFUL TIPS

- Look out for the notes marked staccato and keep them short.
- 1st finger back for D# # and look out for the G# # too (stretch 3rd finger)

## RHYTHM / TEMPO

- Neat, even quavers

   use less bow and
   start them on time
   (you can make the
   note before a tiny
   bit shorter)
- Enjoy the notestied across the barat 16-19
