

MUSIC FOR ALL!

Horsforth Music Centre will be opening again for 2021-22 on **Saturday 18th September**. All ages are welcome, from under-5s to over-60s. We have something for everyone, from fun beginner groups to advanced ensembles, covering all styles and levels of experience.

Free instrument hire Want to try out a new instrument? We can provide a year's free-of-charge instrument hire for beginners (subject to availability). After the first year a small charge applies.

Enrolment You can enrol online now at www.artformsleeds.co.uk, or alternatively come along in person to our enrolment morning on **Saturday September 11th**. To be sure of a place, enrol online as far in advance as you can – some classes will fill up quickly!

Missed enrolment? Don't worry, you can join many classes and groups at any point in the year – contact us for more information.

What does it cost?

We aim to keep Music Centre fees as affordable as possible. There is an **enrolment fee of £36**, payable once per family, to join the Music Centre. If you only want to take one class and are joining on your own, the enrolment fee is just £19 (under 18) or £26 (adult).

A fee is then payable for each class or group you join. The easiest way to pay is via a monthly direct debit, which spreads the cost for the 27 weeks that Music Centres are open over nine equal instalments (October to June).

You can also pay in advance for the whole year if you wish. Cash, cheques and credit cards are accepted.

Concessions Families on qualifying benefits (including Income Support, Jobseeker's Allowance, Child Tax Credit and others) may be eligible for a discount of up to 66% on the above prices, to a maximum of £100 per student.
