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Blue Award

- O Play at least three chromatic scales fluently, using the low, middle and high sections of your range.
- O Play a slow double-tonguing exercise, evenly and in tempo.
- Play a piece requiring half-valve or glissando slide techniques .
- O Play with a wide range of dynamics.
- Shape small phrases with articulations such as accents, staccato, sudden dynamic change.
- O Copy back a tune or rhythm of four bars accurately imitating the articulation and rhythmic feel (e.g. dance such as waltz, jig, shuffle)
- O Decorate a melody or devise a fill.
- O Notated: play and understand time signatures such as 2/2.
- O Unnotated: learn a 16 bar piece from memory recognising patterns: where material is repeated, and where it varies.
- O Play in an ensemble -
- accompanying sensitively adjusting speed and dynamics accordingly;
 - 2) being comfortable taking a solo, or the lead.
- O Play two pieces in different genres, effectively showing the stylistic differences
