# What is safeguarding?

Safeguarding is: Protecting people's health, wellbeing, and human rights; enabling them to live free from harm, abuse and neglect (Care Quality Commission 2016)



Children and young people are people aged 0 – 18 years old. Children and young people are a vulnerable group because of their age. We must safeguard all children and young people from experiencing abuse, harm and/or neglect.

**It is our responsibility to spot signs and indicators – not just wait for a child to disclose a concern to us.**
