Horsforth Music Centre is a place for anyone aged 3 to 93 who wants to enjoy learning or playing music. Whether you're a total beginner or an experienced player, we have something for everyone, from pre-school groups to advanced adult ensembles, and most things in between!

Our 2025-26 session will begin on **Saturday 13th September**.

Need an instrument? We have access to an extensive stock of instruments which students can loan for £18 per term.

Enrolment You can enrol online now at www.horsforthmusic.co.uk. To be sure of a place, enrol online as far in advance as you can – some classes will fill up quickly!

Missed the start of term? Don't worry, you can join many classes and groups at any point in the year – contact us for more information.

What does it cost?

We aim to keep Music Centre fees as affordable as possible. There is an annual **enrolment fee of £40**, payable once per family, to join the Music Centre. If you only want to do one activity and are joining on your own, the enrolment fee is just £20 (under 18) or £30 (adult).

A fee is then payable for each class or group you join. The easiest way to pay is via a monthly direct debit, which spreads the cost for the 27 weeks that the Music Centres is open over nine equal instalments (October to June). You can also pay in advance for the whole year if you wish.
