What does it cost?

We aim to keep Music Centre fees as affordable as possible. There is an annual **enrolment fee of** £40, payable once per family, to join the Music Centre. If you only want to do one activity and are joining on your own, the enrolment fee is just £20 (under 18) or £30 (adult).

A fee is then payable for each class or group you join. The easiest way to pay is via a monthly direct debit, which spreads the cost for the 27 weeks that the Music Centres is open over nine equal instalments (October to June). You can also pay in advance for the whole year if you wish.
